WVASHRAE GAC News:

State Energy Benchmarking Program::

WV Energy Office and WV ASHRAE announced the WV State Energy Benchmarking Program at the annual WVASFA Conference in Morgantown on July 8, 2019. The WVASFA annual conference is for Public School Facility Managers,

Administrators, and other Maintenance Personnel and it highlights new technology for the management of buildings and surrounding grounds.

Mr Tommy Young, WV Dept of Education, introduced ASHRAE Members Art Hallstrom and Garrett Weaver who explained how the new project tracks district building energy usage using Energy Usage Intensity (EUI) and Energy Star. EUI is very much like MPG for a car.

Participating PK-12 public school districts can track their energy usage and compare it to national and ASHRAE benchmarking criteria. Energy Star studies have shown doing energy benchmarking saves an average of 2.9% of the utility bill.

The WV ASHRAE Benchmarking Project is sponsored by a grant from the WV State Energy Office and the EPA. The support for this project from the Energy Office is made possible through grants that were awarded to the Energy Office with the assistance of WVASHRAE.
